#### **KENYA**

Credit Bank is set to receive a Sh824 million from African Development Bank (AFDB) for onward lending to small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs)

The World Bank will dish out **Sh.1.5 billion** to 750 businesses that will emerge as winners in the just launched 10- week online competition, MbeleNaBiz (Daily Nation).

Sony Nyanza Sugar (Sony Sugar) is seeking more than **Sh300 million** capital injection from unnamed investors to carry out repairs of machinery whose condition is blamed for dismal output. (Daily Nation)

The World Bank, through the National government, has given out a grant of Sh 111.5 million to a non-governmental organization (NGO) for the implementation of various agricultural activities in 20 wards of Homa Bay County. (MYGOV)

Non-governmental Body Child fund Kenya will spend Sh5.5 billion in the next three years on projects tailored to benefit the youth and children. (Daily Nation).

Isiolo abattoir will benefit from **Sh800 million** funding from the World Bank in efforts to boost livestock trade. (Daily Nation)

Logistics solutions firm Pewin Group has inked a **Sh 7.3 billion** deal with a Belarussian agricultural machinery maker Aftrade DMCC to put up a local tractor assembly plant. (Daily Nation)

An Austrian Bank will fund a **Sh800 million** water Project in Mokubo village in Bomachoge Chache. Unicredit Bank has signed an agreement to finance the Mokubo water project that will pump out 1 million cubic mettres of water each day and serve residents in two neighbouring constituencies Bomachoge Borabu and South Mugirango.(The Standard)

The United Kingdom has boosted Uganda's fight against malaria with Shs206b for a period of five years. ### **TANZANIA**

Cross Boundary Energy Access (CBEA), Africa's first dedicated fund for commercial and industrial solar power (PV), has recently announced its first transaction to finance 60 mini-grids in Tanzania. The project is in partnership with Powergen Renewable energy, one of the leading mini-grid developers and operators in Africa.
