Bakhresa Group of Companies which owns one of the largest flour milling plants in Kenya, has invested **(\$120million)** in a **fruit processing** plant in Tanzania. (Business Daily)

The African Development Bank Last week approved **\$53 million** in new financing for small and new businesses across Africa in a plan to **nurture entrepreneurship** on the continent (The East African)

Britain has set aside **\$30million** to help East Africa exploits its **crude oil and natural gas** discoveries by developing industry legislation and regulation with emphasis on local content (The East African)

# KENYA

Belgian government has given Kenya a Kshs 2.4 billion (\$24million) loan to support establishment of County Connectivity system that will also help **budget planning** of county governments. The third phase of the program was signed by Minister Didier Reynders and CS Rotich on 21<sup>st</sup> of November 2016, (The East African )

**Diamond Trust Bank Kenya** (DTB) has secured a **\$75million** (**Sh7.5 billion**) funding, including a \$50 million line of credit for on lending and \$25million subordinated debt, from the African Development Bank (AFDB). (Business Daily)

Dry water Taps are expected to start running again following the roll out of an ambitious project to improve **water infrastructure**. The **Sh2 billion** project funded by the World Bank is being implemented in phases beginning with sealing of water leakages in Nyali and Kisauni (The Standard)

# TANZANIA

Royal Dutch Shell and its partners-Pavillion Energy and Ophir Energy have announced the commencement of **gas drilling** off the coast of Tanzania in a **\$ 80 million** investment project. (The East African)

Swala Oil and Gas Tanzania is seeking to raise **\$120 million (Over Sh 250billion)** to **finance material transaction** after recently acquiring an exploration block in Burundi (Business Daily)

#### UGANDA

Uganda has received **\$214 million** from Tullow Oil to date in the **settlement of disputed** capital gains tax dues arising from the company's sale of interest in oil blocks in the country. (The East Africa)
