

- •LIFE is the EU's funding instrument for **environmental and climate action**.
- •The general objective of LIFE is to contribute to the implementation, updating and development of Community policy and legislation on the environment and climate (water, air, waste, etc.) by **co-financing projects with European added value**.
- •The LIFE programme finances pilot demonstration projects.
- •Some SME Instrument environmental projects are eligible for LIFE funding.

WHAT ARE THE STARTUP EUROPE AWARDS MEXICO?

The Startup Europe Awards Mexico (SEAM) is an open innovation contest where specialized startups in the agrifood sector are identified and promoted. The implementation of this European model stems from a strategic alliance between Fundación Finnova (FINNOVA) and actors in the agrifood sector in Mexico.

WHICH IS ITS GOAL?

This private sector initiative aims to identify, drive and link agro-entrepreneurs who generate technological innovation with key agents to detonate smart business in an open innovation ecosystem.

StartUps that have innovative and disruptive solutions to the challenges faced by the agrifood sector in Mexico in the areas of water, social innovation, climate, gastronomy and agritech will be able to scale up their services and products at local, regional, national and global levels, through public and private collaboration.























The implementation of this European model arises from a strategic alliance between the Finnova Foundation (FINNOVA), its delegation in Chile, the Association of Technological Companies of Chile, ACTI and local actors from the sectors of intelligent cities, innovation and entrepreneurship in Chile, within the framework of the organization of the Expo Innovation Forum Ciudad Futuro (27 and 28 March 2019).

StartUp Europe Awards Chile (SEUACH) is the open innovation methodology that identifies and promotes, in its first edition of 2019, specialized startups with solutions for the challenges of Intelligent Cities, Climate and Water established in Chile.
