



- Instrumentos financieros: Combinación de **subvenciones, préstamos** en condiciones favorables y **garantías** para reducir el riesgo de inversiones privadas.
- Herramientas operativas: **Asistencia técnica**, diálogo político y económico, acuerdos comerciales y de inversión y normalización.
- La **participación del sector privado** es clave!



Compromisos financieros

- De 2021-2027: **Equipo Europa movilizará inversiones de hasta € 300.000 Millones**
- CE: financiamiento por vía de instrumentos como NDICI, IPA III
 - **€135.000 Millones: Inversiones facilitadas por EFSD+**
 - **€18.000 Millones en subvenciones**
- BEI, BERD e instituciones de financiación del desarrollo de estados miembros: **€145.000 Millones de volúmenes de inversión**







