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#### **5. FINANCIAL INCENTIVES**

### AGRICULTURE

- Excessive fragmentation of ownership has led to a decrease in the degree of mechanization and equipment, lower agricultural productivity and ultimately led to the practice of subsistence agriculture.
- Recently, associated systems were set up to operate larger area of land.

## Iași International Airport – CARGO TERMINAL

In **January 2017**, Iași county administration decided to continue with the 2<sup>nd</sup> stage of the modernisation of Iași International Airport.

laşi County Council initiated the **concession** proceedings for a land surface to host a **hangar suitable to serve as an aircraft repair base for Boeing and Airbus**.

The investment is estimated at **EUR 10 million**.

An old building of the Utilitarian Aviation will be renovated to set up a Cargo area on a surface of 3000 sqm.

The Cargo Terminal is included in the *Romanian Transportation Masterplan 2015 – 2030*, but no funding is foreseen before 2023.

Therefore, Iași County Council is looking for private investment to build the CARGO terminal before this deadline.



The CARGO terminal is part of Iași Future Hub project, which also includes the Intermodal Center Iasi – Holboca.

## Regional Intermodal Freight Transport Centre Iași - Holboca

Context. Assessing needs and opportunities.

The Intermodal Centre is one of the key elements to transform Iași into a sustainable business hub.

**laşi Future Hub** aims to capitalize on opportunities and local infrastructure and build around their capabilities to enable the county to become a prominent turntable for cargo and passenger traffic at the border of the European Union with the Republic of Moldova, Ukraine and Russia.

laşi today hosts one of the **most dynamic regional international airports** in the Eastern Europe. The **proximity to major urban centres in the Region** creates the prerequisites for a sustainable development in the medium and long term, but only in conjunction with **the diversification of the services** provided and **the ability to ensure interconnection** of roads and railways. IAȘI provides unique logistic facilities, ensuring interoperability between the Russian railway track gauge and the European railway system.

## Regional Intermodal Freight Transport Centre Iași - Holboca

#### Investment description.

The project consists in the execution of the **railway, road and parking infrastructure works,** thus ensuring the interconnection to the national railway and road network, as well as the connection to utilities.

#### The key elements of the targeted investment:

- temporary storage platform of intermodal freight units (especially containers); the platform will enable a height of 5 containers on an area of 6.4 hectares;
- provision of utilities (electricity, drainage, water supply, sewerage, etc.);
- communication, security system and rail access and related railway infrastructure;
- $\succ$  road and rail infrastructure within the terminal.

#### **TECHNICAL DETAILS:**

- ► Covered area: 24 ha;
- Platforms for Loading/Unloading containers: 6,4 ha;
- ► Container number: 1760 pcs.;
- Capacity: 100 trucks/ day (RO-LA);
- ► Transit: 21,900 trucks / year (RO-LA).

lași Intermodal Centre is included as a strategic objective in the Romanian Transportation Masterplan 2015-2030, but no funding is provided.

The technical and economic documentation was finished this year and the procedure for the joint venture approval by the National Railway Company is ongoing.

Type of investment sought: publicprivate partnership (PPP - BPO) or concession.

## Industrial Park – Lețcani, Iași

Main road connections: DN28 (E583), DJ248A, DJ248.

Railway connections with other functional areas of the country. Iaşi International Airport - 15 km away.

#### Estimated value:

EUR 5 million.

#### 2014, May:

Legal registration of the Industrial Park Management Company.

#### 2017, August:

Granted the title of industrial park.

#### Incentives for industrial parks:

a) deduction/exemption from fees charged for destination change or for removal from farm-use classification of the industrial park land;

b) deduction/exemption from land fees related to the industrial park land;

c) deduction/exemption from building tax on industrial park buildings;

d) deduction/exemption, only with local public authority approval, from local taxes any taxes due to the local budget of administrative-territorial organizations for urban planning certificate issuances, building permits for the land and the buildings belonging to the industrial park area;

e) any other benefits that may be granted by local public authorities in accordance with the law.



## Industrial Park – Lețcani, Iași

#### PROs

- ▶ 18,6 ha land available;
- utilities in place (road access, water supply, gas, electricity, telecommunication);
- highly qualified human resources (a pool of 60,000 students in lasi and surroundings);
- investments in technical fields of production could benefit from a highly skilled labor pool available immediately (professionals from communist companies – FORTUS - CUG, ŢESĂTURA - shut down after 1989 or later in siderurgy, metalurgy, electrotechnics, engines, textiles etc.);
- fiscal incentives according to Romanian law for industrial parks;
- investments in technology and RDI are subject to additional fiscal incentives (20% deduction from the eligible costs for RDI);
- larger investments can benefit from state aid schemes;
- possibility to get European Funds for the development of the company.
